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NHS England considered if **Bicester and surround towns, villages and hamlets were a controlled locality** and have determined:

- The **surrounding towns, villages and hamlets are within a Controlled locality (Rural)**
- The **urban boundary of Bicester is within a Non-Controlled locality (Urban).**

The Urban boundary of Bicester was defined as the outer boundary of Bicester Town Council Wards with the inclusion of:

- The Graven Hill Development site
- Caversfield: urban boundary to go from B4100 along Aunt Elms Lane and around the edge of the residential housing.
- Launton: with the urban boundary running around the residential housing, and following the railway lines.

The reasons for this decision were as follows:

- All areas within the defined boundaries, except for the urban boundary of Bicester, had very few, if any, amenities or facilities
- The group felt that residents would have to travel out of the villages to access basic services and they would not therefore be considered to be self-sufficient.
- There was an extensive number of amenities and services within Bicester, including 8 pharmacies, 4 GP practices and other health and leisure facilities.
- There was no clear boundary between Caversfield, Graven Hill and Bicester.
- The Committee concluded that Deddington has a range of facilities, these facilities are usually associated with a large village rather than a small town.
- The Committee concluded that although there will be a range of facilities in the future currently there was very little in the way of facilities at Heyford Park and immediate vicinity.
