


People claiming unemployment benefits in Oxfordshire – claimant count to July 2020

This JSNA Bitesize provides a summary of the latest Department of Work and Pensions claimant count data for Oxfordshire, showing the change between March 2020 and July 2020.

- As of July 2020 there was a total of 17,395 claimants of unemployment benefits in Oxfordshire. This was 695 above the previous month (16,700 in June 2020).
- Each district in Oxfordshire saw a slight increase in claimants between June and July.
- There are also 119,200 people in Oxfordshire supported by the government's Coronavirus Job Retention Scheme (furlough) or Self-Employment Income Support Scheme (to 30 June 2020).



Younger age groups and males have each seen a greater increase in the number of claimants.

- Between July 2019 and July 2020, there was an increase of 2,450 in claimants aged 16-24 and 1,850 in claimants aged 25-29.
- Male claimants in Oxfordshire increased by 7,030 compared with 4,670 additional female claimants.
