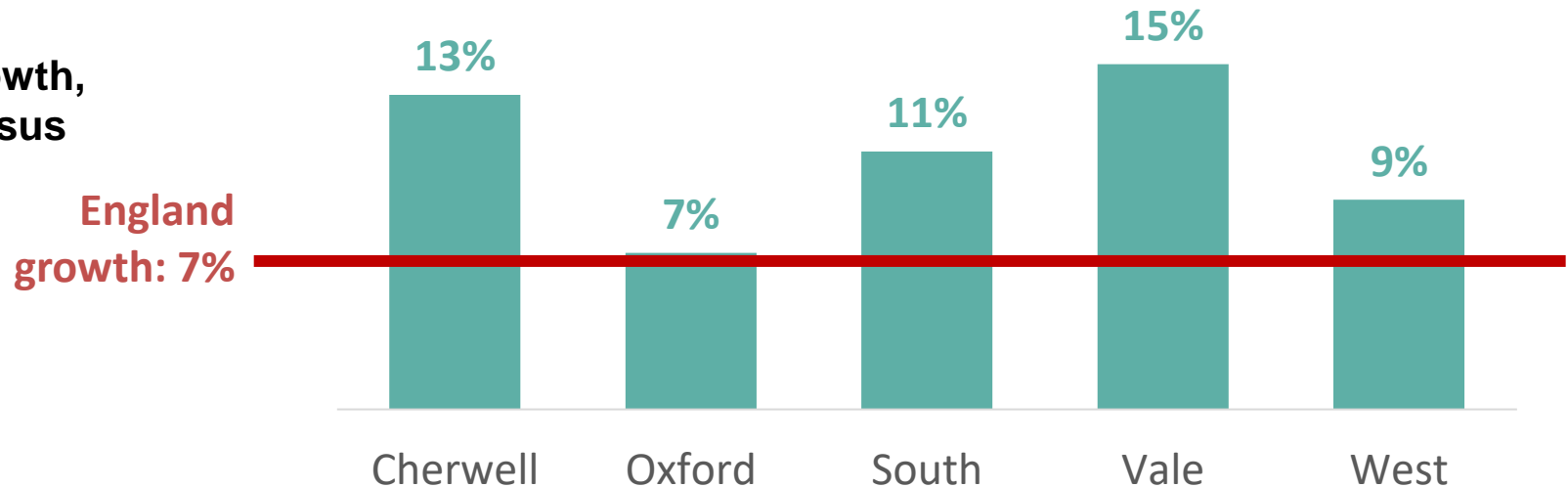

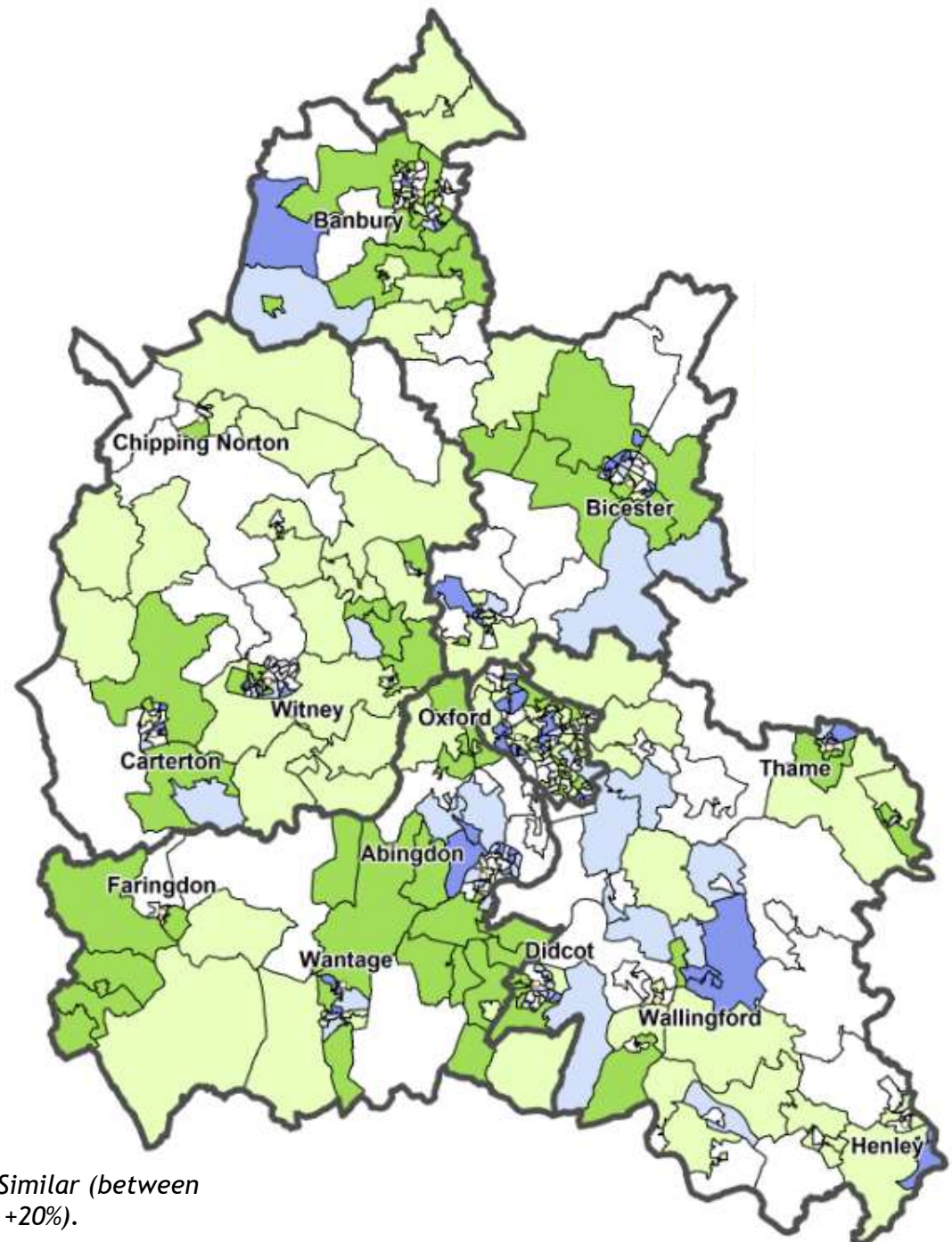
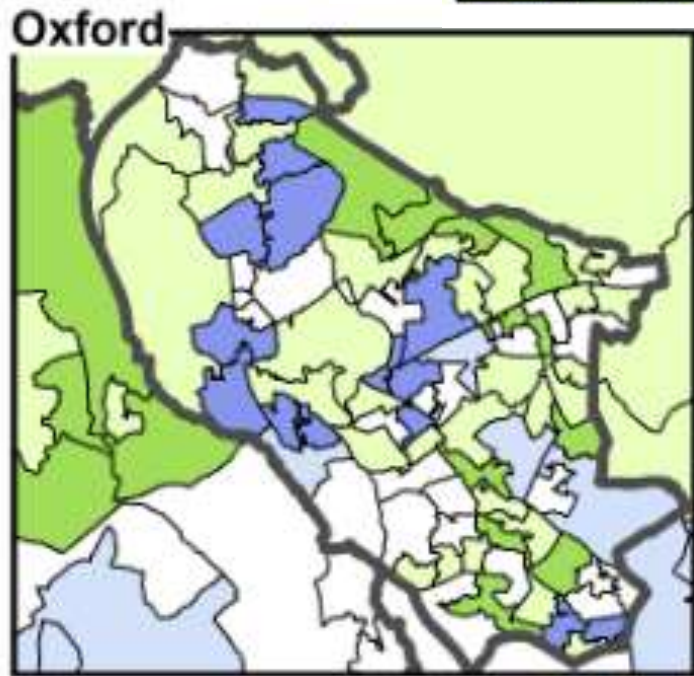
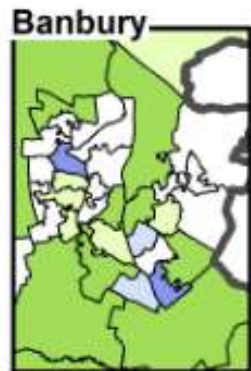
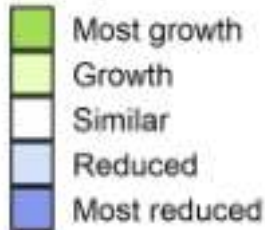
- In 2011, Oxfordshire population was 653,800. In 2021 it has increased by 11%.

Growth at the local level

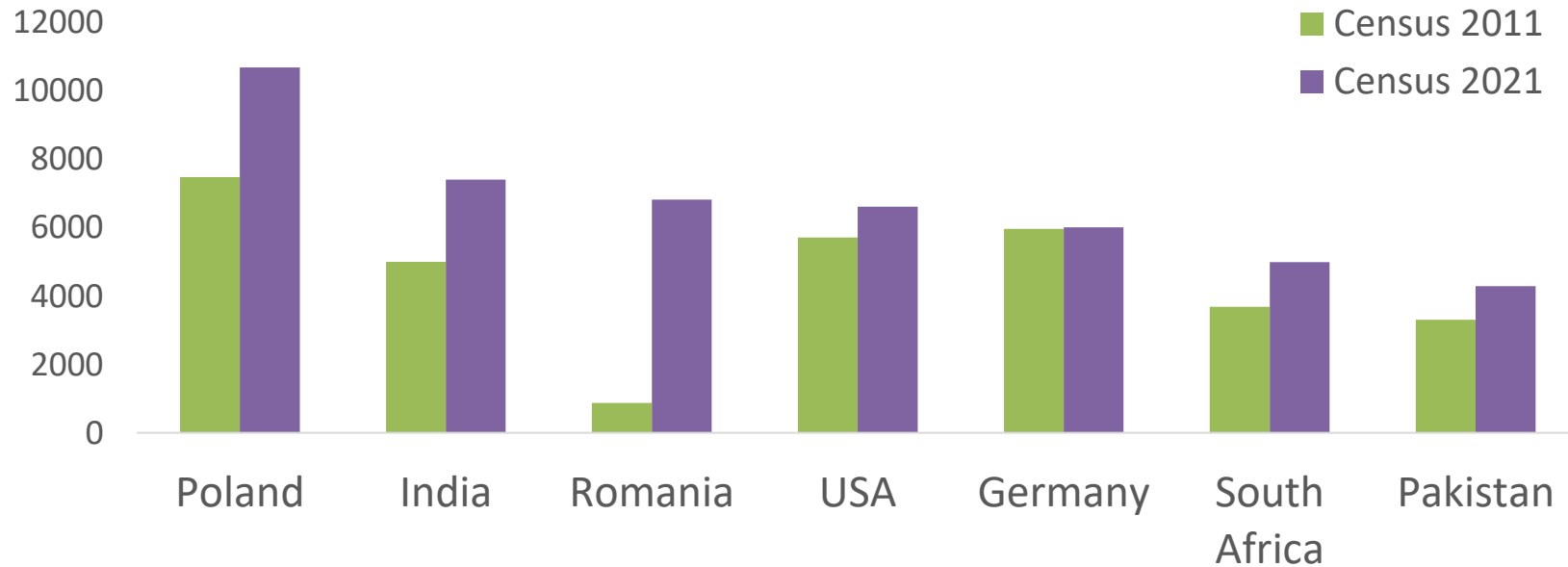
Percentage change in population

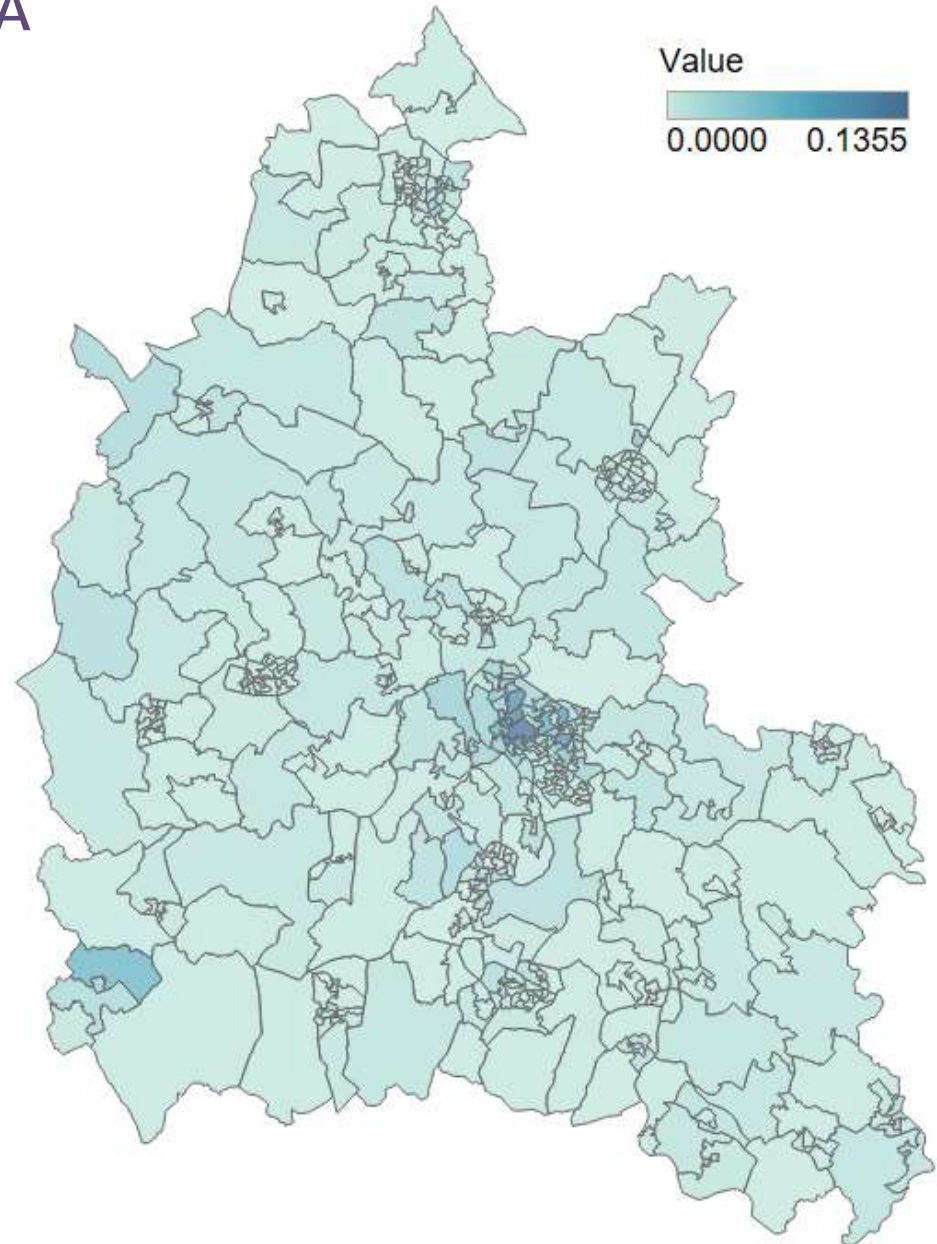

1.6% of couples are same-sex

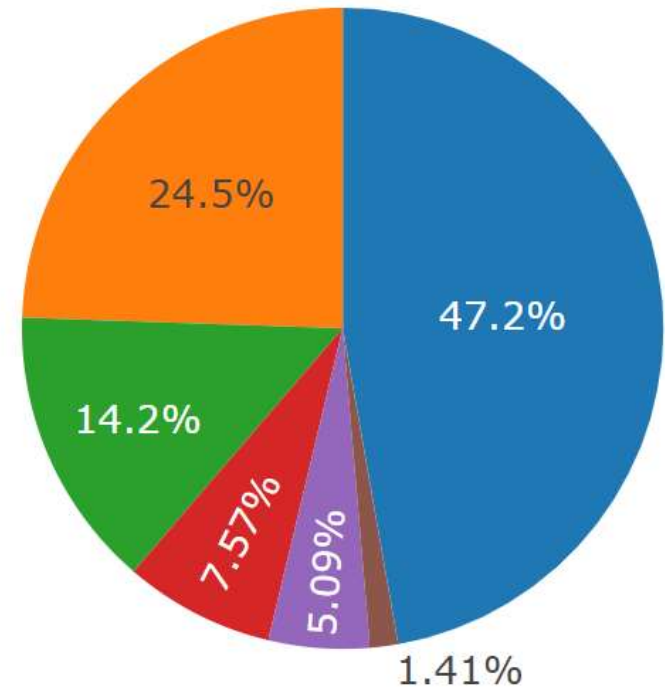
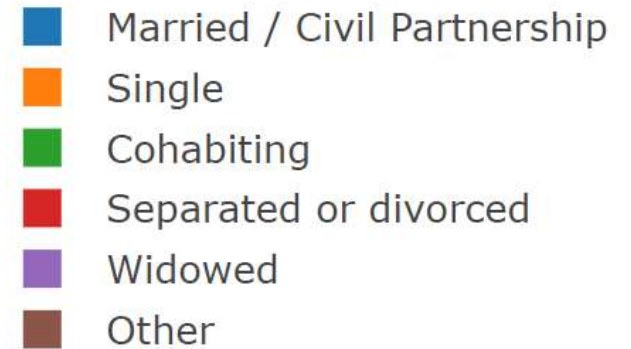
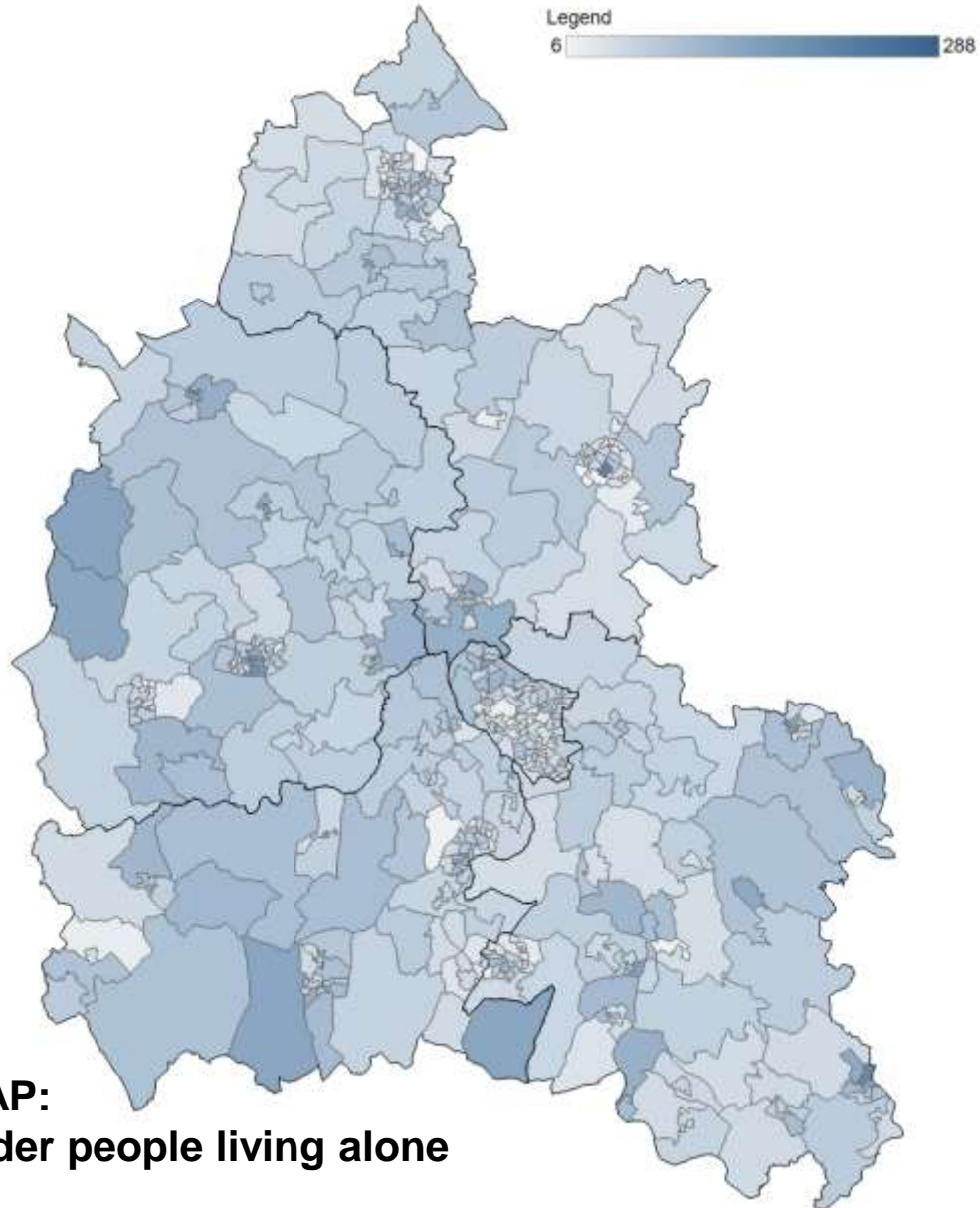


CHART: Living Arrangements (Census Table TS010)

Older people living alone

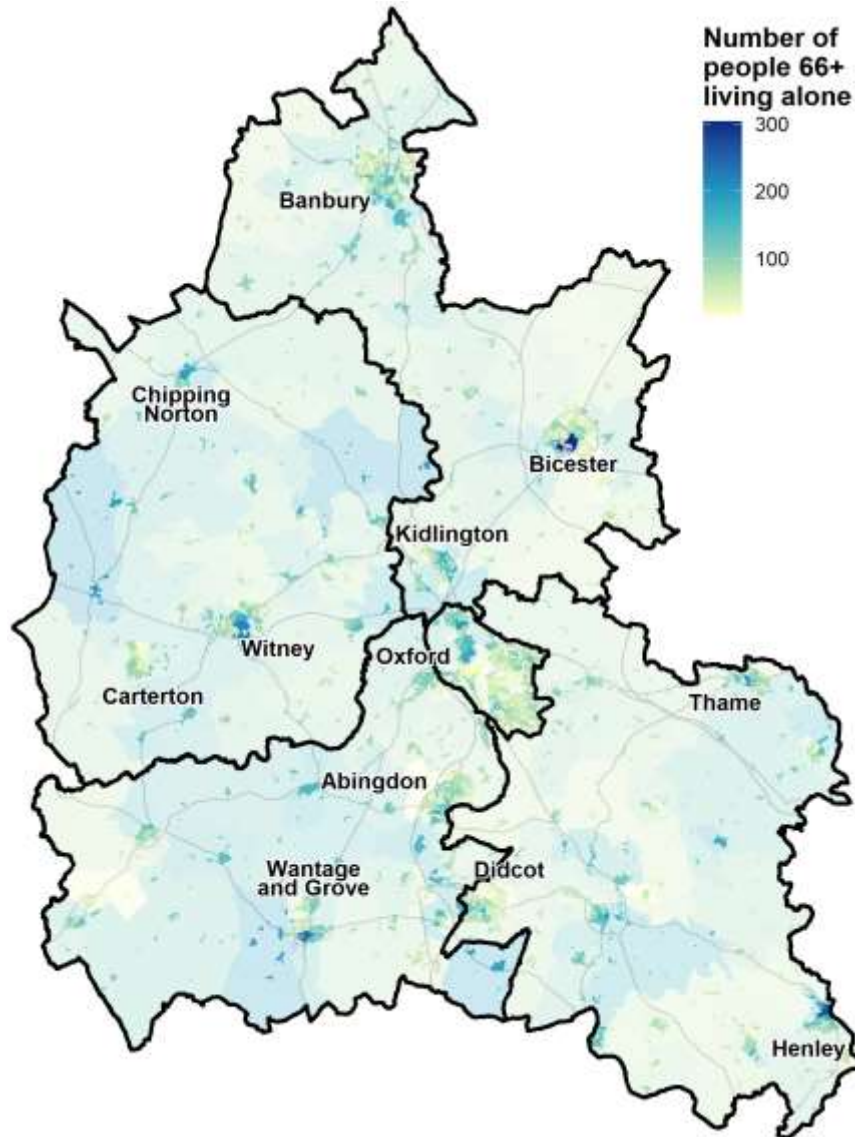

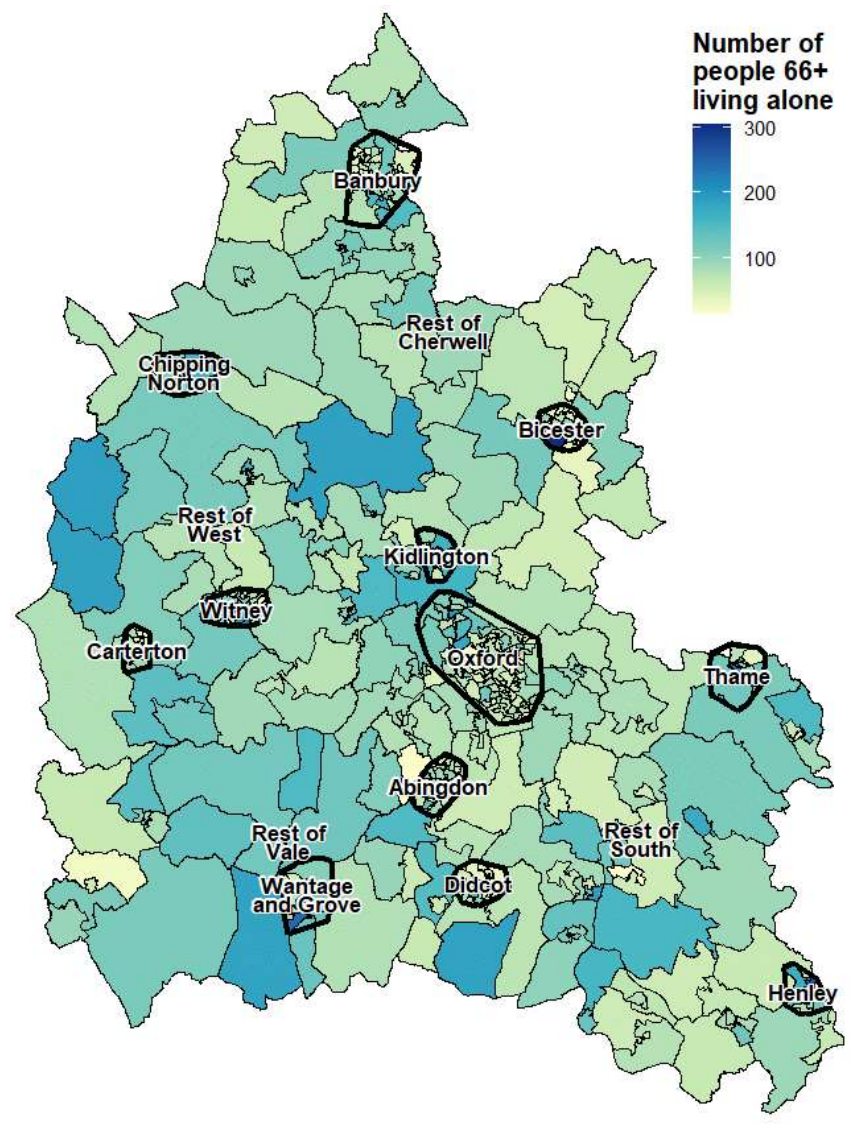

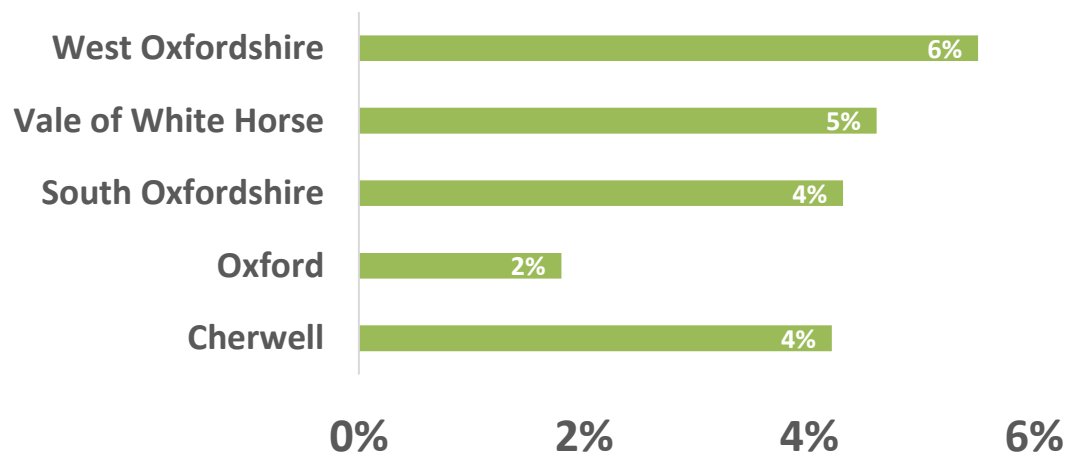


Households: Armed forces veterans

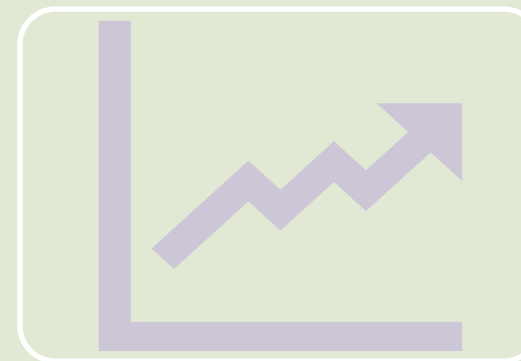
